

2023 Impact Statement

Our mission is: **To enhance the engagement of fathers by promoting a culture of father inclusion and responsible fatherhood in communities.** In collaboration with local schools, community partners, faith-based organizations and private and public agencies, San Bernardino Fatherhood remains true to its mission in serving fathers, children and families in communities.

Here are *some* of our accomplishments in **2023**:

- Facilitated the evidence-based **24:7 Dad AM Fathering Program** to **over 93 men with 65 men successfully graduating.**
- Facilitated the nationally-known, best practice, **Boot Camp for New Dads Workshop** in two locations with **37 new and expecting Dads graduating.**
- Recipient of grant funding to offer **Boot Camp for New Dads Workshops** to new and expecting **Black Dads** as an intervention in **reducing Black infant mortality.**
- Distributed **47,425** diapers to mothers and fathers in the community through our monthly Diaper Giveaway.
- Hosted our **6th Annual Daddy Daughter Dance** with **over 270 individuals** in attendance: including **103 fathers/father-figures** and **132 daughters** of all ages.
- Initiated several proclamations, recognizing the month of **June as Fatherhood Awareness Month** with the **County of San Bernardino, Board of Supervisors**; and the **Cities of San Bernardino, Colton, Fontana, Rialto, and Highland.**
- Hosted several father-friendly community events including **Father's Day Weekend with Inland Empire 66ers Baseball; Dads, Kids, & Family at SB Raceway**; and **A Tribute to Fathers: Jazz/R&B Concert** featuring Walter Beasley and NOJAC.
- Hosted our **2nd Annual Leadership Summit for Fatherhood** with over **65 men and women** in attendance, representing **over 20** organizations, agencies, faith-based organizations, school districts, universities and city and county dignitaries.
- Co-hosted the national **Million Fathers March** at Howard Ingraham Elementary School with 150 students participating and over 50 father/father-figures were present to show support for their children's education.
- Hosted our **5th International Men's Day Event** with over **75 men and family members in attendance**, including representatives from non-profits, community-based organizations, city and county officials.
